## AB 692 Compliance Webinar - Tuesday, December 2nd

**Assembly Bill 692** takes effect on **January 1, 2026** and introduces new prohibitions on employment contracts for workers under California law.

Hiring practices, employment contract templates, bonuses and training cost arrangements must all be re-examined to ensure compliance before the New Year.

## FMCSA Removes Five Devices from ELD List

On November 20th, FMCSA removed the following ELDs from the [list of registered ELDs](#) due to the companies' failure to meet the minimum requirements established in Title 49 CFR Appendix A Subpart B of Part 395.



Below are the five ELDs that have been removed:

Motor carriers **have up to 60 days to replace the revoked ELDs** with compliant ELDs. Motor carriers and drivers who use the ELDs listed above must take the following actions:

1. Discontinue using the revoked ELDs and revert to paper logs or logging software to record required hours of service data.
2. Replace the revoked ELDs with compliant ELDs from the [Registered Devices list](#) before **January 20, 2026**.

## CARB: Clean Fleet Connect Public Workgroup Virtual Meeting

CARB invites you to participate in a **virtual public information session** to discuss a new voluntary, non-monetary incentive initiative, called the **Clean Fleet Connect** tool, that would recognize fleets using medium- and heavy-duty zero-emission vehicles (ZEVs) in California. **At the information session, staff will outline the concept behind this voluntary opportunity, invite input from interested parties, and answer questions.**

The session will be held via Zoom and interested parties must register to participate. Clean Fleet Connect is a tool intended to highlight ZEV fleets, create connections for environmentally conscious businesses, and support the state's broader clean-air and public-health goals. The new tool would publicly recognize fleets that voluntarily choose to align with the state's zero-emission goals and would not establish new regulatory requirements.

The workgroup meeting is scheduled for **Tuesday, December 9, 2025, from 1:00 to 3:00 pm**. Workgroup meetings are open to the public with time set aside for oral comment and questions at the end as time permits.

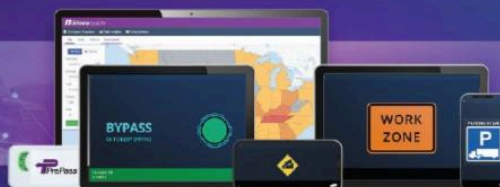

## CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

Caltrans is reminding motorists of various lane and ramp closures in multiple locations along Interstate 80 (I-80) and State Route 20 (SR 20) as several projects continue in Placer and Nevada counties.

Motorists may experience delays between 30 to 45 minutes and are encouraged to factor in additional travel times along the I-80 Sierra corridor.

Here is the breakdown for this week:

### Eastbound I-80

- **Monte Vista Pavement Rehabilitation Project**
  - **Between Monte Vista and Drum Forebay**, various lane and ramp closures are scheduled around the clock from 6 a.m. Monday, **November 24 through 4 a.m. Wednesday, November 26.**
  - **Baxter on- and off-ramps** are closed until further notice. Motorists will detour eastbound to Drum Forebay and return westbound on I-80 to Baxter.
- **Yuba Pass Separation Overhead Bridge Project**
  - **Between Yuba Gap and the junction with SR 20**, various lane closures are scheduled around the clock from 9 p.m. Sunday, November 23 through midnight Wednesday, November 26.
  - **Yuba Gap off- and on-ramps and eastbound I-80 off-ramp to SR 20** are closed until further notice. Motorists will detour eastbound to Eagle Lakes Road and return westbound on I-80 to SR 20 or Yuba Gap.
- **Emergency Culvert Repairs**
  - **Donner Lake Vista Point** is closed and scheduled to reopen at noon Friday, November 28.

- **Between Vista Point and Donner Lake Interchange**, various lane closures are scheduled from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday, November 24 and Tuesday, November 25.

### Westbound I-80

- **Emergency Culvert Repairs between Floriston and Hinton Road**, various lane closures are scheduled from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday, November 24 and Tuesday, November 25.
- **Yuba Pass Separation Overhead Bridge Project between the junction with SR 20 and Yuba Gap**, various lane closures are scheduled around the clock from 9 p.m. Sunday, November 23 through midnight Wednesday, November 26.
- **Monte Vista Pavement Rehabilitation Project between Drum Forebay and Monte Vista**, various lane and ramp closures are scheduled around the clock from 6 a.m. Monday, November 24 through 4 a.m. Wednesday, November 26.

### Eastbound SR 20

- **Yuba Pass Separation Overhead Bridge Project**
  - **SR 20 on-ramp to eastbound I-80**, scheduled to be intermittently closed from 9 p.m. Sunday, November 23 through midnight Wednesday, November 26. When closed, motorists will detour westbound to Emigrant Gap and head back eastbound on I-80.
  - **SR 20 on-ramp to westbound I-80**, will be intermittently closed until further notice. Motorists will detour eastbound to Eagle Lakes Road and head back westbound on I-80.

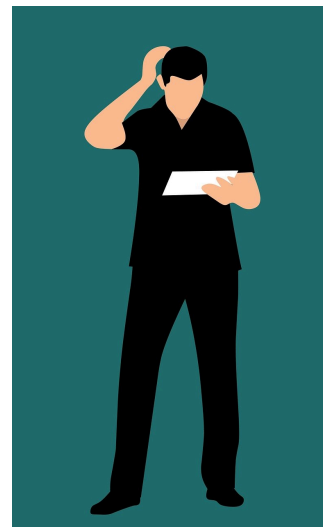
