Here is what to expect from each policy committee meeting:

Kingpin Committee - CTA staff will review the success of our annual California Trucking Day, provide a grassroots update on our advocacy efforts, and take a look forward into the upcoming 2026 elections in the California State Legislature.

Safety, Security, and HR Policy Committee - The meeting will cover pressing topics such as FMCSA's Interim Final Rule on non-domiciled CDLs that includes a presentation from the Deputy Director of the CA Department of Motor Vehicles, review of the English Language Proficiency requirement, updated on the electronic medical certificate rule, and a legislative update.

Highway Policy Committee - The Highway Policy Committee will discuss insights into the Road User Charge program and provide a review of the California Freight Mobility Plan 2027 and the CalSTA Surface Transportation Reauthorization. The Committee will also discuss the freight planning for the 2028 LA Olympics, truck route changes on I - 580 and truck parking changes on I - 5, and finally a review of the 2025 legislative priorities.

Environmental Policy Committee - The Enviro Policy Committee meeting will review CARB's repeal of the Advanced Clean Fleets regulation, share the latest news on Clean Truck Check, EPA DEF guidance, and what's happening with the Omnibus and Advanced Clean Trucks rules.
